



# Memorandum of Cooperation Agreement Between Texas Association of African American Chambers of Commerce (TAAACC) and The University of Texas at Austin

This Memorandum of Cooperation Agreement (Memorandum) is entered into between the University of Texas at Austin (UT) and the Texas Association of African American Chambers of Commerce (TAAACC) on this 15th day of August, 1985. The purpose of this agreement is to provide for the cooperation and collaboration between the two organizations in the areas of research, education, and community development. The TAAACC is a non-profit organization that is dedicated to the economic and social advancement of African Americans in Texas. The University of Texas at Austin is a public institution of higher learning that is committed to the advancement of knowledge and the service of the state. The two organizations have agreed to cooperate in the following areas:

1. The TAAACC will provide information and assistance to the University of Texas at Austin regarding the needs and interests of African Americans in Texas.
