

**Memorandum of Cooperation Agreement
Between
Texas Association of African American
Chambers of Commerce (TAAACC)
and
University of Houston**

The Memorandum of Cooperation Agreement (Memorandum) covers the conditions from March 15, 2017 to March 14, 2018, as well as an open period agreement to be extended by either the Memorandum by either party. The Texas Association of African American Chambers of Commerce (TAAACC), a nonprofit affiliate and the University of Houston, for the purpose of strengthening and expanding the economic development opportunities of Houston's underserved business community with the goal of Texas' TAAACC and the University of Houston will engage in the development of initiatives regarding marketing, business development and other opportunities connected with members of underserved business level of HRB (non-profit agencies, TAAACC) by carrying out programs and TAAACC will use the University of Houston, March 15, 2017

BY: TAAACC, for University of Houston and TAAACC, agree to the following:

Program Activities:

- 1) TAAACC will provide marketing services to members in an effort to create and develop a listing of African American business for small to medium HRB. These services include marketing and HRB member information that will be used to improve HRB programs.
- 2) Over time the university may also be involved in the university of Houston. The University of Houston will provide marketing and HRB member information that will be used to improve HRB programs.
